

ACCEPTANCE OF THE GOODS, DELIVERED BY EUROBALT

1. These Acceptance Conditions shall apply when the goods are delivered from EUROBALT to the CUSTOMER and define acceptance of the goods produced or sourced by EUROBALT, independently if they are shipped or stored at EUROBALT facilities or 3rd party warehouses as per EUROBALT instructions and requirements.
2. Acceptance tests are being performed based on the requirements of paragraph 6 of the ORGALIME S2012 01 EN, as per following instructions: acceptance tests provided for in the Contract shall, unless other is agreed in written, sealed and signed as a contract, be carried out at the place indicated by EUROBALT during normal working hours. If the technical requirements aren't specified, the tests shall be carried out in accordance with EUROBALT general practice in the appropriate batch of industry.
3. Notification is being processed based on the requirements of paragraph 7 of the ORGALIME S2012 01 EN, as per following instructions: EUROBALT shall notify the CUSTOMER in written that the goods are being tested and is obligated to provide corresponding test report, the test report sent to the CUSTOMER shall be accepted as accurate.
4. Delivery terms, passing of risks and acceptance of the goods is based on requirements of the paragraph 10 of the ORGALIME S2012 01 EN, as per following instructions: the terms for delivery shall be agreed in written between parties as per requirements of INCOTERMS, unless other is indicated, delivery terms are FCA Tallinn. Goods are considered as accepted by the CUSTOMER as soon as corresponding invoice, packing list and quality control report are being provided.
5. These terms and conditions are considered as master, unless other is signed between the EUROBALT and the CUSTOMER in a form of a contract, sealed and signed by both parties.
